German-language children's and young adult books are very much in demand among international licensees and a real export hit for German, Austrian and Swiss publishers, being the top selling foreign rights category.

The deeper you get into the topic of justice, the trickier it gets! In this book, Assata Frauhammer explains to children what justice is and how difficult it can be to always act fairly. In an easy-to-understand way, she describes what justice has to do with democracy, what communism is, why generational justice is important, and why there is so much inequality in the world.

Assata Frauhammer, born in 1991, works as a freelance author and likes to write about exciting non-fiction topics.

Ada is looking forward to going to school, but sometimes she feels a twinge of fear. Stefanie Höfler describes all these jumbled feelings and moods in many touching (everyday) episodes that combine to make one big story. Whether it's tingling chocolate-cake feelings or stupid arguments, anger at her little brother or biting jealousy of Leila, special Mummy-and-Ada moments, courage, trust or the immortal soul of a chicken, Philip Waechter's tenderly poetic pictures and comics dive into the depths of all these contradictory feelings.

Stefanie Höfler is a teacher and theatre pedagogue. In addition to her multiple award-winning novels for young people,

all of which were nominated for the DJLP, she also writes children's and picture books.

Rosi and Leo are a great team of explorers! They help Astrid, the isopod, to find her way back to her rock. On the way, the clever creepy-crawly chats about the finer points of animal dwellings: from busy beehives to nests at lofty heights to burrows under the ground. The two children discover what it's like to carry their house around with them, weave a nest out of blades of grass, and build a beaver's lodge. The clear text and warm-hearted illustrations inspire children to explore the great outdoors, and serve as visual guides for little experiments.

Katrin Wiehle studied communication design in Kiel. She was awarded the Talented Young Artist's Prize by the German Academy for Children's and Young Adult Literature in 2011 for her picture book debut, Professor Pfeffers tierisches Abenteuer. Her nature book, Mein kleiner Wald (My Little Forest) won the Stiftung Buchkunst award for most beautiful book.

When solving these tasks, children develop thinking skills in sorting and classifying, which involve visual perception (sorting by colour, shape and pattern) and logical thinking (categorising, classifying and finding the odd one out in groups of objects).

When sorting and classifying items, children group them according to certain characteristics or attributes (e.g. colour, shape, size) and find similarities and differences between objects.

The learning cards *Sorting and Classifying* help children to develop a range of thinking skills and build the foundations for later problem-solving.

The charming illustrations offer a creative take on the role of imagination in children's play.

Reto Crameri was born in Berne in 1975 and studied at Biel University of Design and at the Haute École d'Art et de Design in Geneva. He has lived and worked in French-speaking Switzerland as a freelance illustrator ever since.
